Navigational Updates for 'Bikepacking in the Canadian Rockies'

Below is a list of updates to the navigational cues featured in the first print of the guidebook. These updates will bring the written cues in the book in line with the GPX files provided at bikepack.ca/routes/guidebook. The guidebook is an important resource for planning and research, however, it is recommended that you use the GPX files for navigation while on route. If you choose to rely solely on the written cues (not recommended), be sure to make note of these changes.

Page 46, 19.3 km	"Turn left right , heading down the High Rockies "
Page 49, 20.3 km	"Opa!" is actually " Opal "
Page 49, 23.5 km	"Turn right left into Galatea Creek Provincial"
Page 70, 79 km	"Turn right left on the more established Nicholson"
Page 78, 55.7 km	"Turn right left on Towers Trail."
Page 104, 5.9 km	"Turn left right at a T-junction with 9 Avenue."
Page 109, 84 km	"Fork right, then right again left in 800m"
Page 126, 75.6 km	"Turn left on Highway 93 Highway 3 , heading"
Page 127, 78 km	"gravel road, then a quick right left back onto trail"
Page 140, 1.5 km	"Turn left on Red Cedar, then left right on Aspen."
Page 155, 4.8 km	"single track heading left right through a patch of"
